


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INTERNATIONAL EDUCATION

Location	 22 minutes from downtown Vancouver 220 km (136 miles) north of Seattle, Washington Approximately 25 minutes by car from the US/Canada border 					
Weather	• Mild, west coast climate (20 to 30°C in summer, 0-10°C in winter)					
Accessibility	 Home to the Vancouver International Airport Excellent public transportation (Skytrain and buses) 					
Safety	Lowest crime rate in Metro Vancouver and BC

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RICHMOND SCHOOL DISTRICT

- Approximately 22,000 Canadian students study in the district
- Students from 6 to 18 (kindergarten to grade 12)
- 10 Secondary schools with grades 8-12
- 38 Elementary schools with grades K-7
- Class size: 19 to 28, depending on grade and class make up.
- Students study the BC Curriculum options for IB Diploma and Certificate
- Government-certified teachers
- 95% of students in Canada attend public schools. Education is high quality and standardized.

Academic Programs

For students who wish to get credit for their education, either in Canada or in their home country



Short Term Programs

For students who want to practice and develop English in a Canadian school



Other Programs

Digital Media, Group Programs, Professional Learning Programs, Connections Program



PROGRAM OPTIONS

- ACADEMIC PROGRAMS
 - RIE Academic Semester Programs 5 months
 - RIE Academic Year Programs 10 months
 - RIE Graduation Programs 1.5 years or more

NON-ACADEMIC/SHORT TERM PROGRAMS

- Summer Camps 3 to 6 weeks (Digital Media)
- Canadian School Experience Program 1 to 4 months
- OTHER PROGRAMS
 - Digital Media, Group Programs, Professional Learning Programs, Connections Program – combination programs



COURSE OPTIONS

The Canadian education system allows students to choose between required and elective courses. Students will often have different class schedules and courses than their friends.

Education is standardized, and all schools will offer strong required courses required for graduation



Required Courses Examples

- English (Language Arts)

- Science

 Music, Graphic Design, Architecture, Law, Screenwriting, Acting, Robotics




COURSE OPTIONS

Richmond also offers a number of excellent academic course options in addition to the standard courses required for post-secondary entrance.

ELL SCHEDULE

Students in Richmond will receive language support that matches their English ability. This is combined with appropriate credit courses. Each ELL level is equal to one academic school year.

Level 1	Little or no English	3 ELL courses, Mathematics and 4 electives
Level 2	Low intermediate English	3 ELL courses, Mathematics, Sciences and 3 electives
Level 3	Upper intermediate English	2 ELL courses, Mathematics, Sciences, Socials Studies, and 3 electives
Level 4	Advanced English	1 ELL course, Mathematics, Sciences, Social Studies, Language Arts (English) and 3 electives
Level 5	Approaching fluency	Language Arts, Mathematics, Sciences, Social Studies, and 4 electives





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SPORTS vs CLUBS

SPORTS

- Offered at most schools
- Students try out for team
- Teams compete against other schools in Richmond and BC
 Examples: Soccer, Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton

CLUBS

- Variety of subjects sports and academics
- Often open to anyone
- May compete at a provincial level Examples: Robotics, Cheer squad, Ski club, Engineering club

- Three meals per day in addition to snacks






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


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


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
